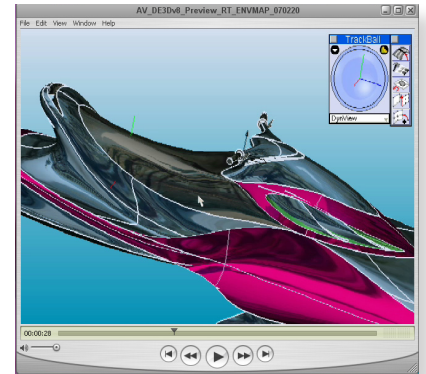
Environment maps provide interactive feedback on surface aesthetics. They are used to

interactively evaluate curved surfaces in real-time rather than waiting for the scan-line rendering used in v7.

When using real-time environment mapping with complex modeling files, we recommend installing a medium- to high-performance workstation-class graphics subsystem.

Please note, that the movie was made using alpha v8 software and

does not yet show the updated interface with the new icons that are coming in v8.

## Student v7 Codes Renewed

Emails were sent to v7 STU license holders asking them to reaffirm their student/instructor status to receive new registration

codes for another year. Students and teachers of design must be currently participating in related design courses and not using the

software to produce commercial work of any kind.

## v7 SP2/SP3 Security Working

The new network-sniffing security built into the most recent v7 service pack releases is working. Last week a packaging company in Canada contacted Ashlar-Vellum Technical Support complaining that "all five of my users get the same error with the IP address." Our initial search

revealed only one v7 license for this company. Further research revealed several additional v6 licenses under the name of a company they'd recently acquired. A quote to upgrade all to v8 has been sent out and a purchase order is in the works.

New price lists reflecting v8 are in the works. Commercial, Academic/Charitable and Student/Teacher Unit price sheets are coming in

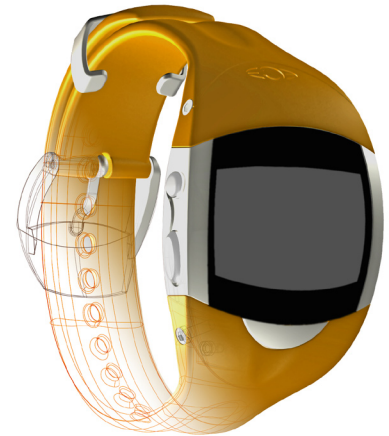
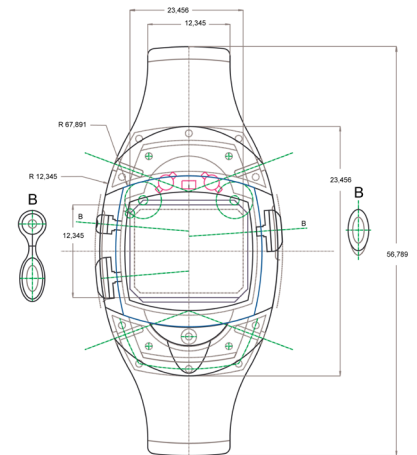
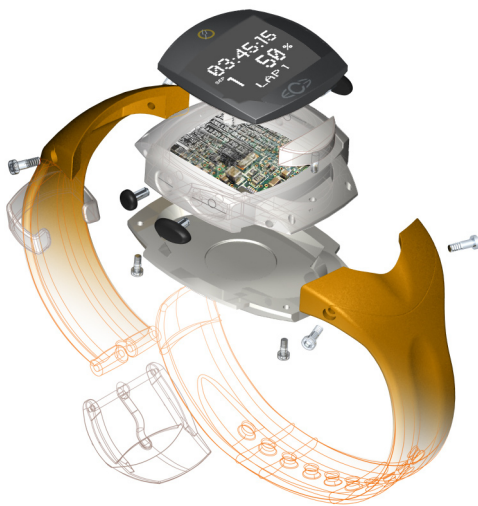
both PDF and Excel spreadsheet format. Updated Sales Handbooks will be coming in the spring. If you have
