

- Spacebar Pan




Use the Mid-point Line Tool to create a line that starts from the center and dynamically draws in both directions until the endpoint is clicked. (New user interface not shown here.)

Graphite v7 Service Pack 3

Sometime next month, we anticipate the release of Graphite v7 SP3. When promoting it to the customer, we say that enhancements in this service pack will include:

- AutoCAD 2004, 2006 DXF/ DWG Support
- Mouse Scroll Wheel Support for Zooming

More importantly to those of us on the inside, the new service pack will include the new security system which will sniff the user's network looking for additional





Incremental Upgrade Pricing

Upon release, the price to upgrade to Graphite v8 will range from US\$495 to \$695 for the e-only version.

Just as we did last year with the pre-sale of Cobalt, Xenon and Argon v7 upgrades, we have created a pricing schedule for Graphite v8 where the price goes up each month over the summer as we approach the release date.

The table shows the e-only prices to:

- Pre-order the upgrade from Graphite v7 to v8.
- Pre-order the upgrade from Graphite v6 or earlier to v8, receiving v7 (including SP3) in the interim
- Upgrade from Graphite v6 or earlier to v7 only (including SP3)

We intend to market these prices within North American only,
