#### SP2, SP3 Releases

Graphite v7 Service Pack 3 and Cobalt, Xenon and Argon v7 Service Pack 2 are in their final stages of testing. Look for customer release of Cobalt, Xenon and Argon by the first week in December. Graphite will follow shortly. "I'm extremely proud of our team," said Robert Bou, president of Ashlar-Vellum. "They worked very hard together to produce excellent products. Each one is committed to creating software that works the way our customers think."

Both service packs incorporate the network checking as part of the new security measures. They also no longer require administrator privileges to run and support AutoCAD 2004, 2006 DXF/DWG. The modeling products have major fixes to Model to Sheet functions in this release, while Graphite supports scroll wheel zooming.

## **Greg's Ashlar Podcast**

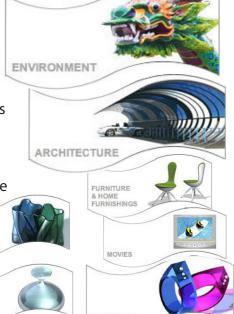
